An excellent programme was prepared and narrated by the club Secretary-Treasurer, Mrs May Bunnett entitled "English Coronation Medals" from Edward VI (1546) to Elizabeth II (1953). The presentation was accompanied by forty coloured slides of which most of the medals shown were owned by the speaker. The majority of the items shown were in silver, but some were gold and bronze. Both the obverse and reverse of each medal was shown and the highlights such as the monarch, his Queen, year, relief, any odd marks or script etc. was pointed out in Mrs. Bunnett's narration.

Many of the monarchs were clad in Roman-like attire and wore laural leaves around their head, others were dressed in armour for battle, both indicating power and strength. Of the seventeen monarchs shown, all medals were official with the exception of Edward VIII who abdicated in 1936 and Queen Elizabeth II for whom none were struck.

An active discussion continued through out the narration showing the keen interest of the members.

The Club's thanks to Mrs. Bunnett for such an interesting and enjoyable presentation.
