The most important portion of the meeting then began. How do we bring life and interest back into the club? This question was put before the members and a number of suggestions followed. As anyone can see, no club can exist on a buget like that for very long.

Other suggestions came out, but they are all pending until the first of the year when we will again assess the club's situation to determine it's future.

We certainly would not like to see less meetings per year, meeting in member's homes, charging a door admission or ultimatly closing the club's doors forever!
