THE WHO'S, WHAT'S and WHY'S of NORTH YORK COIN CLUB (Founded in 1960)
In December 1959 Kenneth Bunnett, of Willowdale, was invited to exhibit some pre-confederation Tokens of Canada at the Main Branch of the North York Public Library in Willowdale.

Many visitors to the Library saw the exhibit, among them John K. Curtis, a local resident and keen numismatist, who suggested to Ken Bunnett that a coin club be formed in North York to serve the northern portion of Metropolitan Toronto and nearby communities.

Mrs. Louise Graham, then General Secretary of the Canadian Numismatic Association, was asked to help get things organized because her wide experience with clubs was invaluable.

In February 1960, the first meeting was called, with fourteen interested people meeting in a small room at the North York Memorial Community Hall, still the home of the club.

The North York Coin Club was born that evening with John K. Curtis elected President; Cecile M. Langille, Vice President; Kenneth Bunnett, Secy-treasurer; Mrs. Louise Graham, Ken Beavis and Herb Samways as Directors. Harvey Farrow was chosen as Librarian.

Other Charter Members were Mrs. Hazel Farrow, Douglas Graham, Elizabeth Wyn Wood, Mrs. Ruth Graham, R. Blake Graham, John Sterling (Junior Member), Kaj. Rasmussen, and Mrs. Retta Frampton.
