Dan Bowyer introduced the Guest Speaker of the evening Mr. Sam Snider.

Mr. Snyder who is well known for his expertise in military medals, especially at the Toronto Coin Club where he holds membership #5, gave an excellent talk on early Canadian Medals relating to battles fought in Canada and outside Canada.

Sam first gave the definition of a medal and explained parts beside the actual medal itself, such as the ribbon, the suspender, and the bars. Sam also explained that as in other branches of numismatics, a collector of militaria must specialize, so he concentrates his collecting efforts to the Seaforth Highlanders. This alone takes him through the reign of nine Monarchs.

Sam brought with him a beautiful collection of medals from the Crimean war, Boer War, The Finnian Raids, The Northwest rebellion, War of 1812-14. The Great War of 1914-18, World War 11, and Korean War. He told many stories of events that happened during the battles and how some of the recipients had won their awards. Sam's presentation was very thorough and enjoyed by all. He was thanked by Harvey Farrow and presented with an Honourary Membership in North York Coin Club for 1982. We hope to see much more of him as he makes use of his Honourary Membership.

Harvey then announced that dues would be accepted for 1982.
