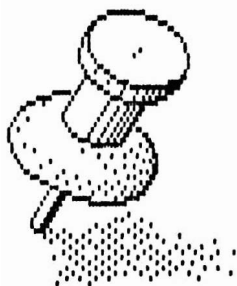

The Door Draw collected \$28.50.

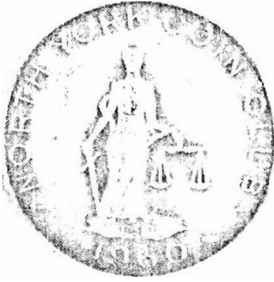
